


# How to Mark a Key as Not Lost and Reset Locks from being Disabling Points

1 Select "Keys."



2 Find the lost key and select "Properties."



3 Click the edit icon  in the Lost Key frame.

## Lost Key ?

4 Mark the key as Not Lost and click Save.; This will delete this key from the system. The key may then be issued to a person or used for a mission.

**Important** - if the key touches a lock that is still set as a disabling point, the key may not work in ANY lock until the key is updated again.
